## Consider the security of a safe deposit box!

A safe deposit box is a convenient place to store important items that would be difficult or impossible to replace. It offers security and privacy, since only the renter knows what is inside.

Safe deposit boxes are a good place to store important papers such as originals of your insurance policies, various certificates, original deeds, titles, or contracts or stocks and bonds. Jewels, collectibles, or any valuable items may

also be housed in a safe deposit box. It is not a good idea to store documents or items that you would need in case of emergency when the bank may not be open.

Although some people like to keep valuables in a safe or file cabinet at home, these places are probably not as resistant to damage or theft. Some insurance companies also charge lower insurance premiums on valuables kept in a bank's safe deposit box instead of at home.

The bank has strict access procedures which include verifying signatures. Only individuals who have jointly signed the bank's rental contract can access the contents of that box. An unauthorized individual could not gain access simply by having a key.

Safe deposit boxes also require the use of two keys. The renter keeps one of the keys and the bank holds the second key. A bank employee must assist in unlocking the box. Renters are offered area where they can sort through the

contents of their safe deposit box in privacy.

Most Fidelity Bank locations offer safe deposit boxes in a variety of sizes, with annual fees at very reasonable prices. All Community Club members receive a free 3x5 box or credit towards a larger box for the first rental year.
